This means that discourteous manners, foul language, drinking, smoking, destruction of property, and any other conduct, which could be interpreted as injurious to the group or individuals in it, will not be tolerated. This also means that directives from chaperones and coaches shall be adhered to. Any swimmer felt to be in violation of these or any PAWW Swim Team Rules, Policies, or Guidelines shall be, at the discretion of the coach(es) and/or chaperones, suspended from one or more events on the following day or possibly sent home at parental expense.

As a parent and/or guardian, I do herewith authorize the treatment by a licensed medical doctor the following minor in the event of a medical emergency which, in the opinion of the attending physician, may endanger his or her life, cause disfigurement, physical impairment or undue discomfort if delayed.

Welcome to the Peoria Park District's USA Swimming sanctioned swim team, the Peoria Area Water Wizards. USA Swimming, the national governing body for amateur competitive swimming in the United States, is responsible for the development of Olympic caliber swimmers in this country through a broad-based age-group program and is a major member of the United States Olympic Committee. Illinois Swimming, Inc. is the local swim committee that charters teams and registers swimmers in Illinois.

The PAWW Swim Team has a long history of impressive accomplishments including state championships, Junior Olympic and state Senior swimmers. The team has Illinois record holders and national swimmers.

The PAWW Swim Team practices year round and participates in swim competitions throughout the year.

Parent's Club

A parent's organization complete with board, officers and committees operates in support of the team. Your help is very valuable.

PAWW Goals and Objectives

The success of PAWW's age-group competitive swimming program is not an accident. It is a well-planned, well-organized series of development stages organized within and toward a clear set of objectives and administered with a consistent philosophy.

To further the success of PAWW's age-group program, the team is structured into three different groups to insure swimmers receive individual attention and instruction.

Team Structure

PAWW is divided into four different groups to insure swimmers receive quality technique instruction and individual attention for their level of swimming. PAWW Swim Groups are:

- Minnows - beginner, non-competitive swimmers; participate in monthly stroke clinic
- Bronze - beginner, competitive swimmers
- Silver - intermediate, competitive swimmers
- Gold - advanced, competitive swimmers

Although each group has specific requirements for placement, our coaching staff will make the final decision on all group placements or advancements.
